Rubin Subdivision – Council toured the Rubin Subdivision.

Centre Street – it was noted that Centre Street was in need of repair.

Nicholetts Road – Council reviewed the surface treatment which had been completed and it was noted that the concern about one of the culverts expressed by a resident did not appear to be a problem.

Boulter Road Culvert – Council reviewed the concern with water pooling in the area and it was noted that a solution to drain the water would be difficult.

Maki Bridge – Council visited the new Maki Bridge. Concern was expressed with the amount of time it took to complete the project.

Weeden Road – Council did not visit this site.

Townline Road from Hwy 102 – It was noted that this area of road was in need of repair and Peter Whittington, Public Works Superintendent advised the asphalt would need to be torn up.

Townline Road – around the hill near Simko Drive (Problem with dumping of garbage, fridges, carcasses, etc.) – Council suggested that the appropriate signs be erected or that this section be closed for the summer months.

Mining Road – Council reviewed the surface treatment on this road.

Fraser Road – Council did not visit this site.

North Landfill Site – It was noted that the new site was open and new signage was in place.

Kakabeka Falls Recreation Centre – Council did not visit this site.

Vibert Road – Municipal Drainage – It was the consensus of Council that the existing drainage ditch between the two properties be left as is and any necessary culvert cleanouts or ditch cleaning along the West Side of Vibert Road be performed by our Public Works Department.

Pennock Drive – Council reviewed the property in question and it was noted that should drainage to adjacent properties or the roadway become an issue, the ditch will have to be opened up.

3298 Rosslyn Road – It was noted that the trees are on Municipal property and no further action will be taken.

Rosslyn Road Drainage Ditch – Council was pleased with the work done in this area.

Rosslyn Road Property identified by LRCA – Council did not attend at this site.

Ridler Road/Brickyard – It was the consensus that access to the property on Ridler Road be left as is and that it be dealt with at the time of any development of the brickyard property.

Coopers Pit – Council had no comments on this site.

Slate River Centre Rink Boards – It was noted that the rink boards had been painted.

Slate River Centre Building – It was noted that the building that was to be removed off the site was in the process of being removed and the work was partially completed.

Agriplex – It was noted that the building was in disrepair and had deteriorated due to neglect.

Candy Mountain Road – Council reviewed the surface treatment on this road.

South Landfill Site – It was noted that the area was tidy and all was in order.

Brushing on River Road – Council had no concerns with the brushing on River Road.
