**Highway 11/17 between Kakabeka Falls and Shabaqua Corners (40 km)**

The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) has initiated a Route Planning Study between Kakabeka Falls and Shabaqua Corners. The purpose of the study is to review and evaluate alternatives for a four-lane divided Highway 11/17.

At the completion of the study, a preferred route will be selected and designated (protected).

A first series of Public Information Centres (PICs) was held in December 2009 to provide the public with an opportunity to review the Corridor Alternatives, and to provide input to the project team. Following the PIC, the project team developed Preliminary Route Alternatives within the Corridors and carried out a screening evaluation of the Preliminary Route Alternatives.

This notice is to announce a second series of PICs. The purpose of the PICs will be to:

- Display and seek input on the screening evaluation of the Preliminary Route Alternatives;
- Display and seek input on the Feasible Route Alternatives; and
- Answer questions about the study.

Notices will be placed in this newspaper to advise the public of future PICs and the publication of the TESR.

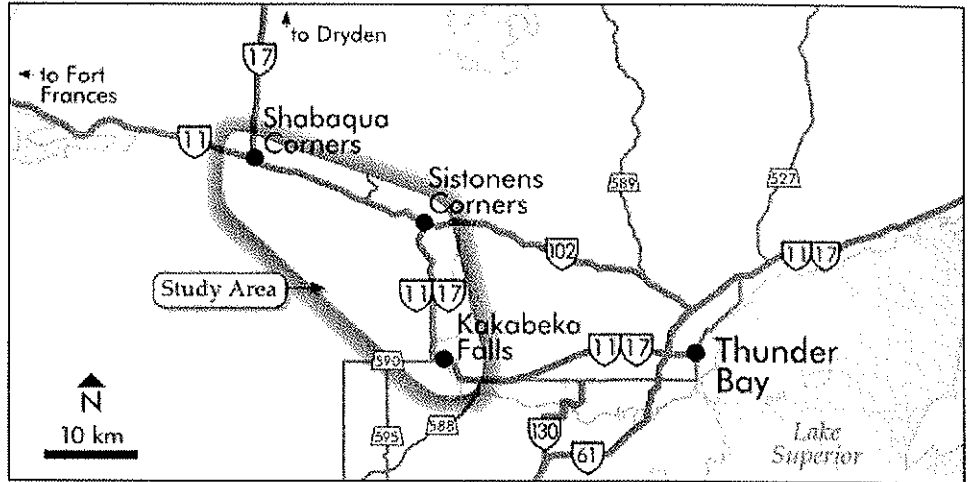
