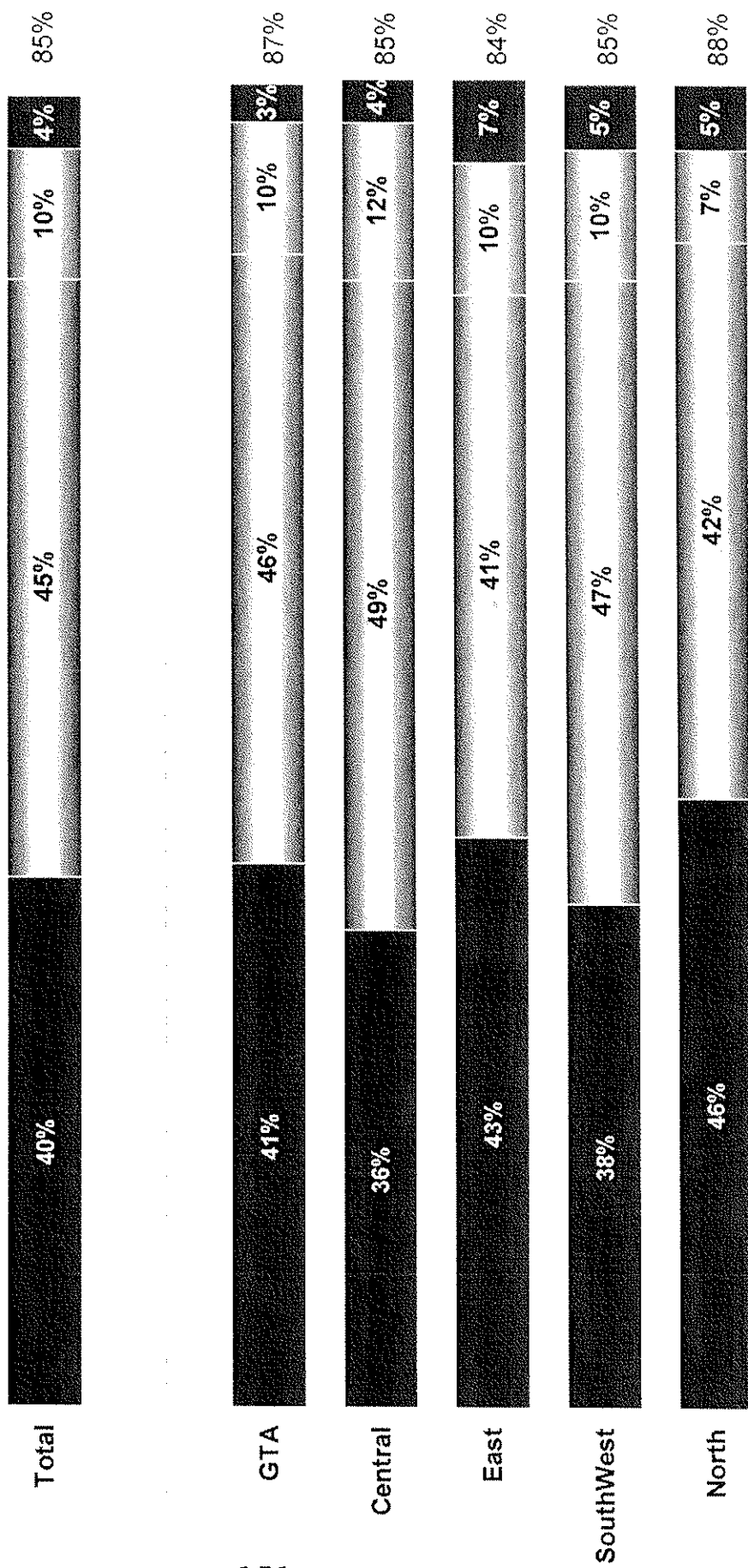




Most (85%) Agree That Wind Energy Development Could Provide Economic Opportunities and Benefits

Q6. Thinking about wind power in general, to what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? Base: All respondents n=1,361

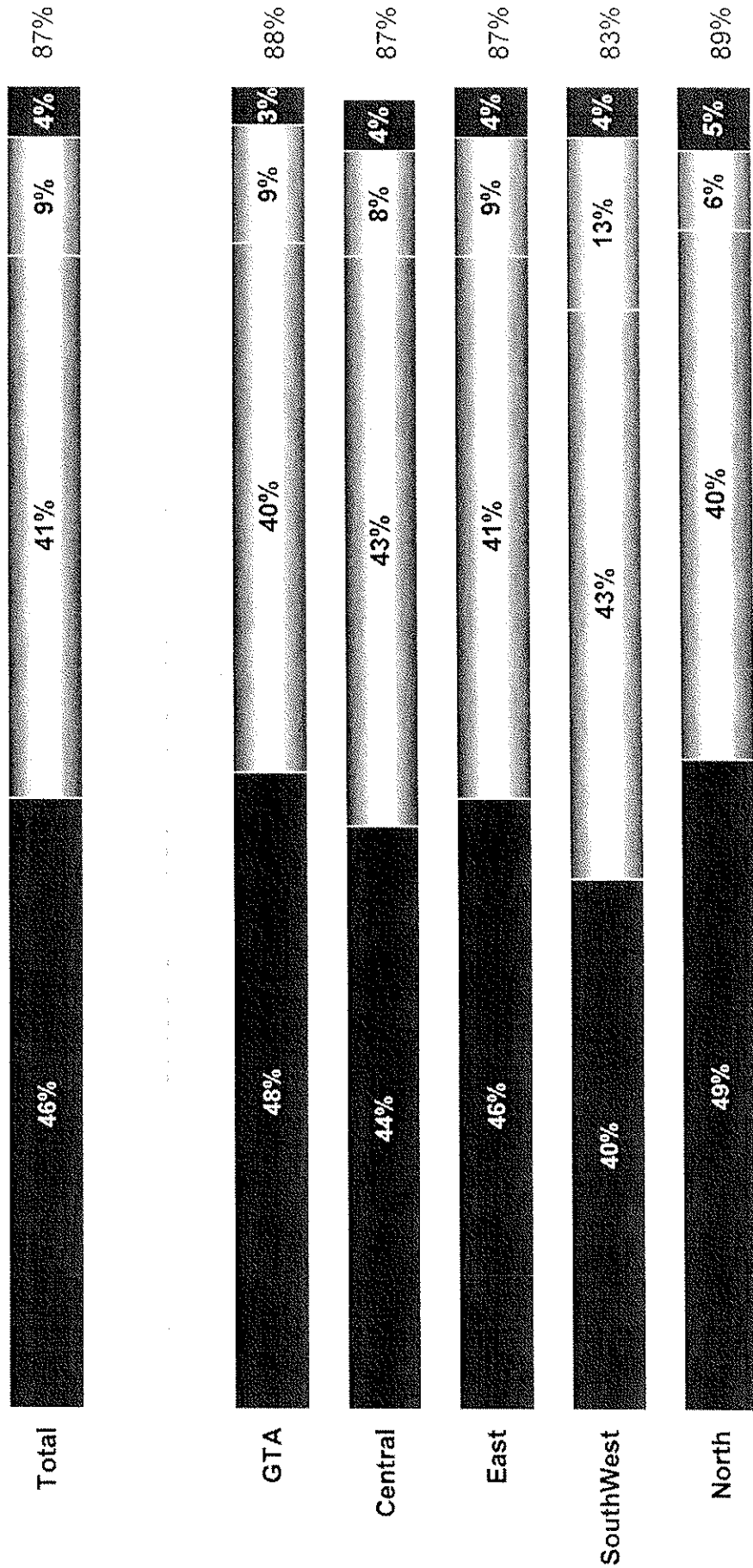


Most (87%) Agree That Wind Turbines Have Less Impact on Human Health Than Other Sources of Electricity
